## **PARKING RULES**

## **Alta Mar Residents & Visitors**

These rules must be followed to avoid your vehicle being towed at <u>your</u> expense.

## **RESIDENTS:**

<u>IMPORTANT</u> – To avoid being towed at your expense, park only in your assigned space.

<u>Registration</u> - Unit owners must register their vehicles on the appropriate form which will be provided by Management. Management will then supply a plastic, static-cling decal for application to the lower left (driver's side) inside corner of the front windshield. Only one parking decal will be issued per parking space. The decal has a unique number which will be kept in Management's computer system for tracking purposes.

<u>Part-time Residents</u>, <u>Seasonal and Renters</u> – all vehicles must be registered at the start of your lease and a parking pass will be given to place on your rear-view mirror and can be discarded at the end of your stay.

<u>Additional Parking</u> – Additional spaces are available to authorized unit occupants on the top level of the parking garage. There is a \$25.00 per month charge for each space. This fee is payable to Alta Mar Condominium Association, Inc. See Management to arrange for additional parking.

## **VISITORS:**

<u>Short-term Visitor Parking</u> – Short-term parking is available in the front driveway for up to 6 hours. Please be aware of the "handicapped" space in this area and abide by the law. Overnight parking is not permitted in this area.

<u>Long-term Visitor Parking</u> - Visitors staying longer than 6 hours will need to register with the Management office to obtain long-term parking authorization. Visitors will then be given a Visitor Pass that is good for 2 weeks.
